



COURSE REGISTRATION (PROCEDURE)

- >> You are to locate any designated biometric registration center for fingerprint scans
- >> You will then be verified
- >> You are to receie your student credentials via text messa not you are to visit the ICT at first floor of the main library

- >> Then you are to visit the student's portal or download the student's app (AIM app) from play store
- >> Use the credentials to login into the app or portal. You are entreated to do the registration yourself to avoid course registration and security issues.
- >> Register your courses, save and print the registration slip
- >> Sign your portion on the printed slip and submit the other part to your department examination officer for endorsement


